

Letter, Mary Burchenal to Emily Bissell, circa February 1915

My dear Miss Bissell:—

I have had two letters<sup>1</sup> from Dr. Edith P.<sup>2</sup> Boffin relative to going to Hope Farm.

I understand from this letter that she cannot afford to pay fifteen dollars a week, and it seems best to me swiftly to put her letters in the hands of the Committee on Admissions.

Will you have the proper person give her the information she desires as to rates, et cetera?
